Please come 15 minutes early.

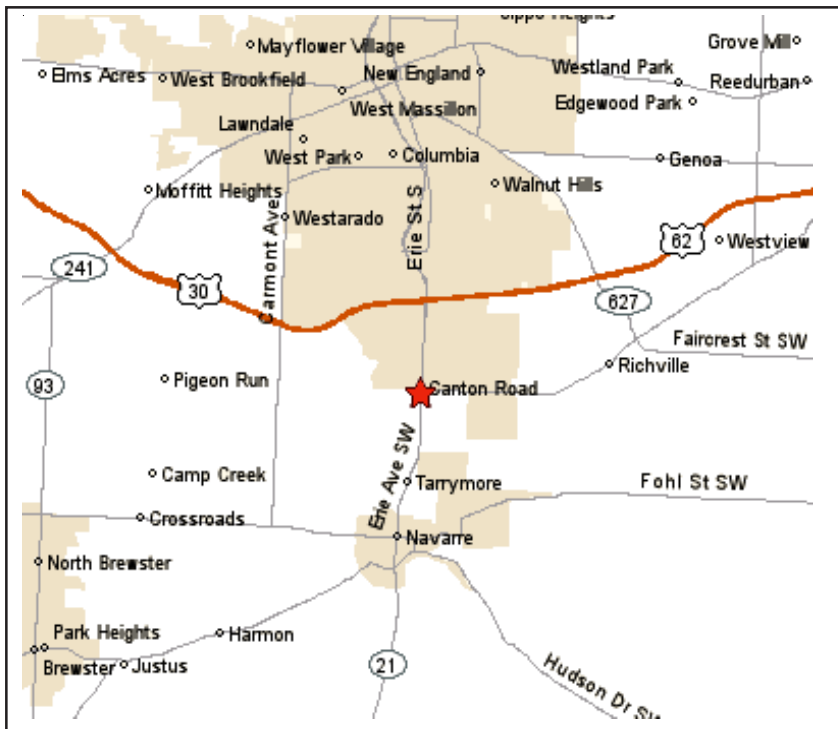

50/50 Winner Gil Bittner

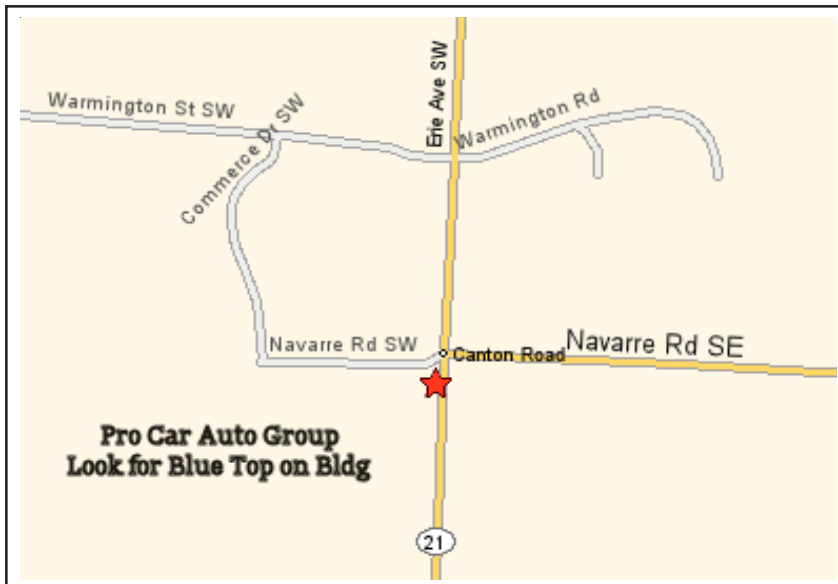


Congratulations to Gil Bittner of Bittner Truck & Repair who won the 50/50 raffle. Gil then generously donated his winnings back to the ATA --
