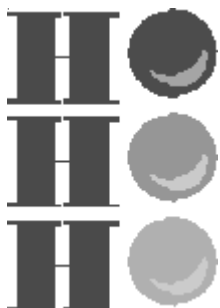

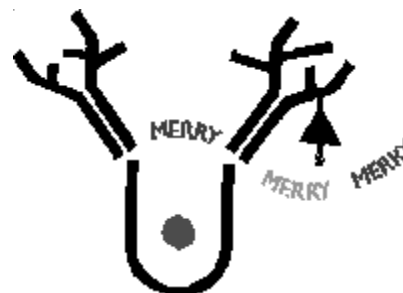


The ATA is paying the donations so please give us the number of people you are bringing and let me know how many will be there.
