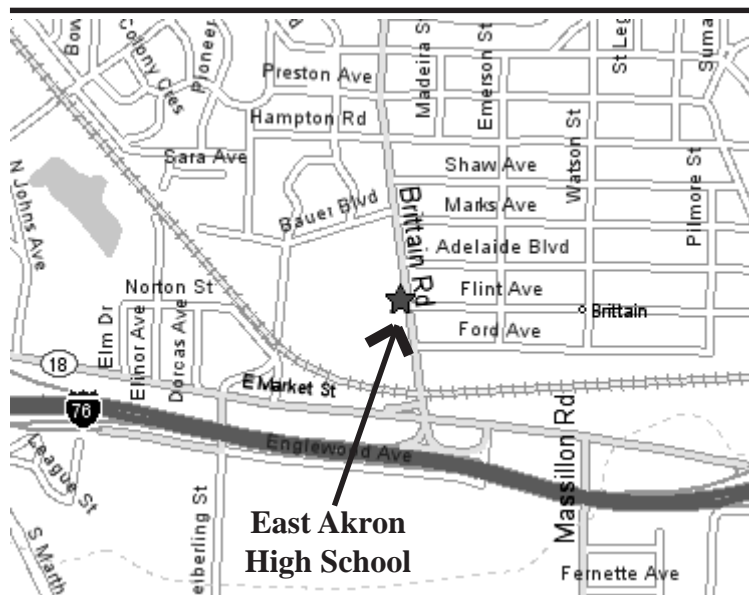
Our 5th Annual Spring Update on A/C Thursday May 6th - 7pm Please come 15 Mins Early
