(\$30 Renewal or \$35 New Member)

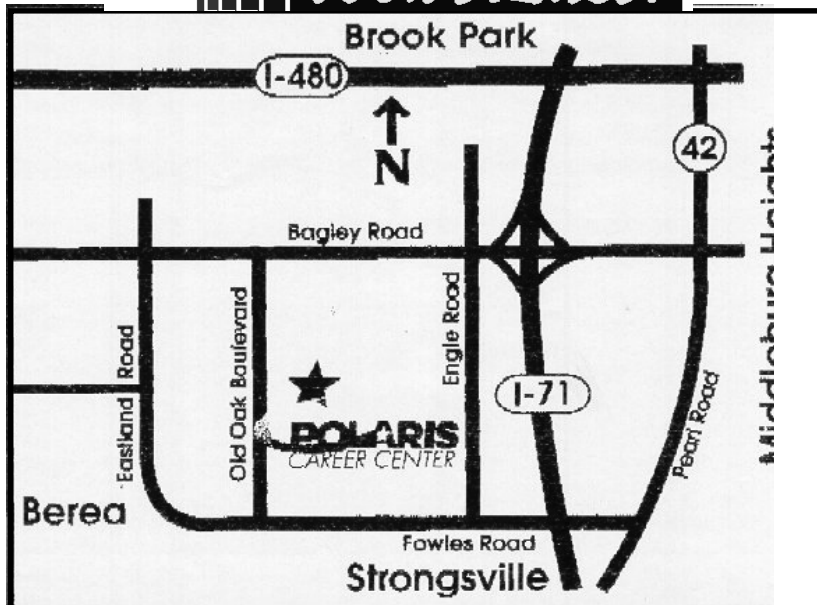

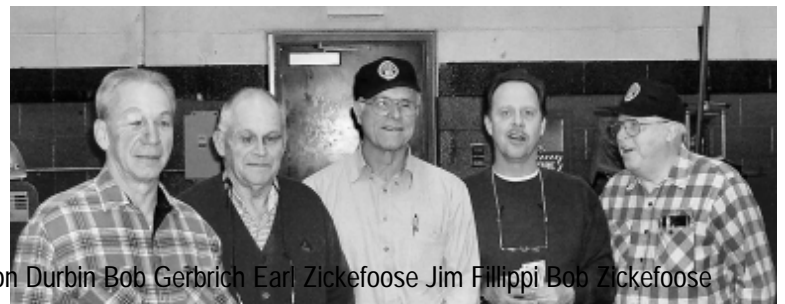
